INSTRUCTIONS

Submit the completed application, payment in the form of a personal check, money order or cashier's check, and any required attachments, to your local County Tax Assessor-Collector's office. **Do not mail cash.** There is no specialty plate fee; however, the annual registration fee must be paid.

NOTE: When the specialty plates are issued, additional fees may be collected to establish a single expiration date for both the specialty plate and the vehicle registration.

If you place your order by mail, contact your County Tax Assessor-Collector's office in two weeks to verify your plates are ready for issuance.

Specialty plate fees will not be refunded once application is submitted. Contact your County Tax Assessor-Collector if you have any questions.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- ♦ Texas title and vehicle registration must be in your name.
- ♦ If you recently filed an application for title, attach a copy of the title application (VTR-500 RTS) receipt.
- ♦ Joint vehicle ownership between you and a spouse is permissible.
- ♦ If the vehicle is leased, attach a photocopy of the lease agreement.
- ♦ Vehicle is for personal use only.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ♦ You must be a mobile amateur radio operator who regularly operates radio equipment that receives and transmits in your vehicle.
- ♦ You must submit a copy of your Mobile Amateur Radio License issued under guidelines set by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) with this application.
- ♦ You may obtain plates for more than one vehicle titled in your name that is equipped with mobile amateur radio equipment. License plates will be issued with the same official amateur call letters to each vehicle registered by the same owner.

LICENSE PLATE TRANSFER

- ♦ You may transfer these plates to another vehicle that is registered in your name.
- ♦ You may not transfer these plates to another owner.

INTERNATIONAL SYMBOL OF ACCESS

To display the International Symbol of Access on your license plate, attach a signed Form VTR-214 to this application to show your eligibility. Contact your County Tax Assessor-Collector's office if you have questions.
